I am pleased to write in support of Arzteverein Fur Afghanische Fluchtlinge (AFAF). This association was founded in 1983 by medical doctors in order to help Afghan refugees in Pakistan.

Between 1983-2002 years, the AFAF provided various medical services for Afghan refugees in Peshawar of Pakistan. They established outpatient clinics, donated medical equipments, built schools and teaching classes for the refugees. In 1987, they set up a diagnostic and therapy center in Peshawar, this center was only for refugees to have their treatment and laboratory tests and it was free of charges.

Since 2002, this association has started its work into Afghanistan in order to enhance the medical services for the poor people. During this time they donated five ambulances and medical equipments to five northwest provinces and assisted various medical machines like ECG, minor surgical instrument, medicine for public hospitals in Kabul.
